

# Inpatient Quality Indicator 09 (IQI 09) Pancreatic Resection Mortality Rate June 2018 Provider-Level Indicator Type of Score: Rate

#### DESCRIPTION

In-hospital deaths per 1,000 discharges with pancreatic resection, ages 18 years and older. Includes metrics to stratify discharges grouped by presence or absence of a diagnosis of pancreatic cancer. Excludes acute pancreatitis discharges, obstetric discharges, and transfers to another hospital.

[NOTE: The software provides the rate per hospital discharge. However, common practice reports the measure as per 1,000 discharges. The user must multiply the rate obtained from the software by 1,000 to report in-hospital deaths per 1,000 hospital discharges.]

#### **Stratification of Indicator**

Strata are mutually exclusive. Patients cannot qualify for more than one stratum.

#### NUMERATOR

Number of deaths (DISP=20) among cases meeting the inclusion and exclusion rules for the denominator.

Note: The indicator is presented in two strata based on the presence or absence of pancreatic cancer diagnosis; The Numerator definitions for Overall, Stratum A and Stratum B are identical.

#### **DENOMINATOR OVERALL**

Discharges, for patients ages 18 years and older, with any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for partial pancreatic resection (*PRPAN3P*<sup>\*</sup>) or any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for total pancreatic resection (*PRPANCP*<sup>\*</sup>).

## **DENOMINATOR OVERALL EXCLUSIONS**

Exclude cases:

- with any-listed ICD-10-CM diagnosis code for acute pancreatitis (*PRPAN2D*<sup>\*</sup>)
- transferring to another short-term hospital (DISP=2)
- MDC 14 (pregnancy, childbirth, and puerperium)

• with missing discharge disposition (DISP=missing), gender (SEX=missing), age (AGE=missing), quarter (DQTR=missing), year (YEAR=missing) or principal diagnosis (DX1=missing)

# DENOMINATOR STRATUM A: PRESENCE OF PANCREATIC CANCER

Discharges, for patients ages 18 years and older, with either:

• any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for partial pancreatic resection (*PRPAN3P*<sup>\*</sup>) and any-listed

ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for pancreatic cancer; (*PRPANCD*<sup>\*</sup>) or

• any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for total pancreatic resection (*PRPANCP*<sup>\*</sup>) and any-listed ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for pancreatic cancer (*PRPANCD*<sup>\*</sup>)

#### DENOMINATOR STRATUM B: ABSENCE OF PANCREATIC CANCER

Discharges, for patients ages 18 years and older, with either:

• any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for partial pancreatic resection (*PRPAN3P*<sup>\*</sup>) without any-

listed ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for pancreatic cancer (*PRPANCD*<sup>\*</sup>); or

• any-listed ICD-10-PCS procedure codes for total pancreatic resection (*PRPANCP*<sup>\*</sup>) without anylisted ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for pancreatic cancer (*PRPANCD*<sup>\*</sup>)

## **DENOMINATOR STRATA EXCLUSIONS**

Exclude cases:

• with any-listed ICD-10-CM diagnosis code for acute pancreatitis (*PRPAN2D*<sup>\*</sup>)

• transferring to another short-term hospital (DISP=2)

• MDC 14 (pregnancy, childbirth, and puerperium)

• with missing discharge disposition (DISP=missing), gender (SEX=missing), age (AGE=missing), quarter (DQTR=missing), year (YEAR=missing) or principal diagnosis (DX1=missing)

Note: The Denominator Exclusions for Stratum A and Stratum B are identical.
